<u>Noting</u> Resolution 2012/08 of the 14th OIML Conference, which states that changes in the classification of Member States take place from the second year of the following financial period,

Noting the information contained in Resolution Conference/2025/06 of the 17th Conference,

Noting Resolutions CIML/2025/10 and CIML/2025/11 of the 60th CIML Meeting,

<u>Considering</u> that the total number of base contributory shares, taking into account the classification of Member States as reviewed in 2025, is 150 for the year 2026 and 161 for the years 2027, 2028 and 2029,

Resolves:

- a) The overall amount of credits necessary for the 2026–2029 financial period shall be €12 209 489;
- b) The base contributory share (annual contribution for a Member State in Class 1 as defined in Article XXVI (1) of B 1:1968 *OIML Convention*) shall be €14 800 in each year of the 2026–2029 financial period.

c) This results in the following annual contributions for the financial period 2026–2029, for Member States classified according to Article XXVI (1) of B 1:1968 *OIML Convention*:

d) This results in the following annual contributions for the financial period 2026–2029, for Corresponding Members classified using the same criteria as for Member States:

e) For the 2026–2029 financial period, newly admitted or readmitted Member States shall not pay an entry fee.
